

Updated Guidelines for Quarantine and Isolation (Updated 4/18/22)

Note: This is provided as a guideline only. All decisions are made by the school administration on a case-by-case basis. Please contact the main office by email (hello@fmsnwa.com) or phone (479-443-7812) if anyone in your household has tested positive. Quarantines will no longer necessarily be required if you are a close contact of someone who has tested positive. As stated previously we will make decisions on a case-by-case basis. This may change at any point if we see a rise in cases.

Please do not bring your children to school if they have one or more of the following:

- Temperature of 100.4 or higher
- Sore throat
- Cough (for students with chronic cough due to allergies or asthma, a change in their cough from baseline)
- Difficulty breathing (for students with asthma, a change from their baseline breathing)
- Diarrhea or vomiting
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever
